

PAGE 2 – ACADEMIC INFORMATION

- **High School you attend/attended:** Enter the name of the high school you now attend, or in the case of a current college student, the high school from which you graduated.
- **Year of Graduation:** Provide the year you will or did graduate from high school.
- **High School Address:** List the street, city, state and zip for your high school, as we sometimes need to contact counselors for additional information.
- **Guidance Counselor:** Provide the title (Ms., Mrs., Mr.) and first and last name of your guidance counselor, and a telephone number where he/she can be reached.
- **Information from High School Transcript:** This information should be on the transcript provided by your guidance counselor for this application. Complete the following as accurately as you are able:
 - a. **Cumulative GPA:** Your GPA through the first semester of your senior year.
 - b. **Rank in Class:** Your rank in class through the first semester of your senior year.
 - c. **SAT/ACT Scores:** SAT Scores should be recorded on your transcript. Provide the highest score for each category (for SAT-Critical Reading, Math, and Writing or for ACT-English, Math, Reading, Science and Writing). If the SAT or ACT Scores are not on your transcript, a copy of your score report from SAT or ACT is acceptable.
 - d. **SAT II Subject Tests:** All SAT II subject tests taken and the scores you've received should be listed. These should also be on your transcript or you may submit a copy of your score report with the application.
 - e. **AP Courses:** All AP courses you have taken should be listed along with the test scores or the date they are to be taken. If you will not be taking an AP test for a course listed, write "Not Taking" in the "Date to be Taken" column.
 - f. **Current Courses:** (for High School students only) List all the courses you are taking first semester in the first column and second semester in the second column (the courses you are currently taking). If a course is a year-long course, you should list it in both columns. Be sure to include the level of the course (i.e. AP, Honors, CP). Page 6 of this application asks your guidance counselor for a School Profile, which normally explains course levels.

Please Note: If your transcript includes only grades, GPA, and/or rank through junior year, please be sure that your guidance counselor includes a first semester grade report with your transcript.
