

**PAGE 3 – ESSAY PAGE**

- A. **Essay – Event or Person:** This essay is the long essay, with B and C calling for shorter, handwritten answers. Essay A should be computer generated, or typed, and double spaced; and although there is no length requirement it should be at least one page, and well written and concise. Please write your name on the essay. This could well be an essay which you have written for entrance to one of your college choices, and revised for the purposes of the Phillips Scholarship application. Due to the high numbers of applications we receive, we cannot interview each student, so this is your chance to give us a sense of who you are and how well you can write.
- B. **Goals:** In your own handwriting and in the space provided, list three goals you have for yourself and explain why these goals are important to you.
- C. **Activity Essay:** Choose a job or activity that you have listed on the next page (page 4) of the application, and, in your own handwriting, explain why it has been significant and of value to you, your school, community and/or family.
