

PAGE 4 – ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM

- **Activities:** Read carefully what is required in this question, as you are asked to list five activities at school (outside the classroom), in your community or at home, which for the past three years have taken a significant amount of your time and have been of value to you, your school, community and/or family. For each of the five, enter the activity on the first line and circle the years of participation and list the position which you held (i.e. editor, president, captain, lead soloist). On the second line for each, enter in the box the number of days each year you were involved, followed by a description for each of the five, explaining what the activity entailed and how you were involved. During the evaluation process, we sometimes check with guidance, community service or employers to verify the activities listed.

- **Employment:** List the jobs you have held, beginning with the most recent. We want to know the employer or company name, the position (i.e. bank teller, ice cream scooper, babysitter), the hours per week during the summer and/or school year, and the dates of employment. Enter the dates in the following format: 6/07 to 8/07 (indicating a summer job only) or 1/08 to present (indicating a job during the school year). We do check employment information from this page with your IRS 1040 form. If you did not work in the past 12 months, please explain why not. Mrs. Phillips expected that all students applying for a scholarship would work to contribute to their college education, and we continue that expectation.
